

MAIN FIGURES OF CARRIAGE IN THE FIRST HALF OF 2011

In the first half of 2011 the extent of freight transportation grew by 10.9%, and passenger transportation grew by 0.8%.

Over the reported period the freight transportation by railway increased by 13.9%, transit flows by railway from/to Klaipėda Seaport grew by 26.2%, and via Kaliningrad District increased by 1.9%.

In the first half of 2011 the amount of goods transported by road reached 23 million tons, which is by 7% more than in the corresponding period of 2010. Within the first half of 2011 there were registered 1373 traffic accidents (or by 9% less than in the first half of 2010), during which 134 people were killed in accidents (by 15.5% more than in the corresponding period of 2010), and 1646 people were injured (by 10.6% less than in the corresponding period of 2010).

Over the reported period the amount of incoming and outgoing passengers in Lithuanian international airports increased by 17.2%. Now the amount reaches 1.2 million passengers. Also the amount of cargo and mail transported by air grew by 19.6%.

The extent of cargo handling at Klaipėda Seaport increased by 22.6%, container handling grew by 49.3%, ro-ro units – by 20.1%. Transit transport via Klaipėda Seaport increased by 27.3%. The share of transit goods handled at Klaipėda Seaport in the first half of 2011 made 43.6% (in the first half of 2010 – 42%).

One of the main economic indices of transport activities is the balance of the 3 months of the year 2011, which showed that the export of services reached 1.8 billion LTL, import – 1.1 billion LTL. Lithuania has earned 0.7 billion LTL (positive saldo). Actually, transport sector makes 67.7% of the total Lithuanian export of services.

The contribution of transport and warehousing activities into the general national value added (VAT) increased from 8.97 billion LTL in 2009 to 10.58 billion LTL in 2010 (+17.9%). If calculated by percentage value the contribution increased from 10.9% within the period of the year 2009 to 12.5% within of the year 2010.
